1. Correspondence, 1966-2016 (9 boxes)

This section consists of Farber's correspondence throughout his extensive academic career. The correspondence section is sorted into three categories: Individual Correspondence, Organizational Correspondence, and General Correspondence. Individuals with whom Farber frequently corresponded, such as his graduate students, and "VIP"s like Linus Pauling are filed under Individual Correspondence. Academic journals and organizations, most notably the *History of Science Society*, are found in Organizational Correspondence. Bulk mailings and other materials are included in General Correspondence.

Box**2. Academia, 1961-2011 (18 boxes)**

This series documents Farber's academic career from his participation in a summer biology program at Syracuse University through his professorship at Oregon State University. Included are class notes and research papers from undergraduate and graduate studies at Syracuse University, University of Pittsburgh, and Indiana University. The Oregon State University materials consist of correspondence, information from courses taught by Farber, Department of History records, and Horning Endowment Fund records. Also included in this series are programs from assorted professional meetings, along with Farber's planners, calendars, newspaper clippings, and digital media. Items of special note include Farber's Ph.D. thesis "Buffon's Concept of Species" and a 16 mm film in which Farber demonstrates the method that Galen of Pergamon would have used to dissect a pig.
