Subgroup 17. Paul G. Risser, 1995-2002 1996-1998 (8.9 cubic feet)

Subgroup 17 of the President's Office Records document the presidency of Paul G. Risser and are organized into seven series: I. Speeches; II. Accreditation; III. Correspondence; IV. Committees; V. Subject Files; VI. Memberships; and VII. Memorabilia.

Series I consists of a brochure of the 1997 OSU University Day address by President Risser. The accreditation records consist primarily of correspondence and self-study reports relating to the review and certification of existing and proposed academic programs. Included among the programs examined in these reports are the College of Business Accounting and Business Administration programs and a proposal for a joint Masters of Public Health Program.

The correspondence documents exchanges between the President's Office, the university community, and the public concerning topics such as the achievements and honors of alumni, OSU athletics, statewide political measures, and the coordination of special events on campus. This series also includes reference letters sent by Risser on behalf of former employees and memoranda and announcements sent via e-mail from the President's Office to OSU staff and faculty pertaining to particular campus events and issues.

Series V consists of correspondence and meeting minutes from Oregon State System of Higher Education and university committees, including the President's Cabinet, an advisory committee of OSU administrators and deans formed by Risser in 1996.

The subject files document the President's Office interaction with the various colleges and departments of the university, as well as relations with the Oregon University System (OUS), Oregon State government, and Corvallis/Benton County. Organized alphabetically and consisting largely of correspondence, minutes, newspaper clippings, publications, and reports, these records pertain primarily to administrative issues and the university's public image, covering such topics as: fundraising campaigns, student enrollment, budget model restructure, marketing, and statewide political measures.

Series VI documents Risser's involvement on committees, councils, and boards of national and state-level educational organizations not affiliated directly with OSU and contains primarily correspondence, minutes, and reports. Included among the organizations represented in this series are: Association of State Universities and Land Grant Colleges, the School Transformation Advisory Council, and the Certificate of Advanced Mastery State Advisory Committee.

Series VII, memorabilia, consists of a wall plaque presented to Risser by the Asian Reporter newspaper for Most Exemplary Volunteer Effort.

Paul Gillian Risser assumed the Presidency of OSU in January 1996. With a doctorate in botany and a professional background in teaching and university administration, Risser came to OSU from Miami University in Ohio where he served as University President for three years. In his presidency, Risser was noted for his emphasis upon the need for increased marketing and student recruitment and retention. In December 2002, Risser left OSU to assume the position of Chancellor of the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education.
