



As representatives of 285 overseas Chinese organiza-tions in 47 countries and territories, we declare once again our opposition to the admission of Red China into the United Nations.

It has never enjoyed the support of the Chinese people. And because of its desperation, the regime today is more danger-ous to world peace and security than ever before. Now it is trying to brandish its erude and limited nuclear weapons for international blackmail.

We represent 17,000,000 overseas Chinese living in every part of the world. While most of us are loyal and peace-lowing citizens of the countries in which we live, we cannot view the momentuse events now taking place in the land of our anesterons without estimates concern. We are particularly distribute by the threat of extinction faxed by Chinese culture and tradition on the mainland.

We urge all Americans to heed the warning sounded by Vice President Hubert H. Humphrey on October 15 that: "The threat to world peace is militant, aggressive Asian com-munism, with its headquarters in Peking."

We urge the United Nations General Assembly to defeat once and for all the move to bring the Chinese Communist regime into the world body.

At this critical juncture, the Free World must refrain from giving aid and comfort to Mao Tse-tung and his cohorts, for such help will be tantamount to prolonging this tyranny and foreclosing the chance for the enslaved millions on the Chinese mainland to regain their freedom.


