1. Landscapes (Forests and Mountains) Photograph Collection

1. Assorted Landscapes and Aerial View Photograph, [The identifier P024:001 has been assigned to a set of six photographs. Depicted in this set are scenes of flood plains, a snowy creek, a double exposed mechanical device and an aerial photograph of an industrial complex in Hillsboro, Oregon.]
2. Hills and Mountains, [The identifier P024:002 has been assigned to a set of four photographs. The subjects of these photographs include an unidentified hillside and the peak of Mount Jefferson.]
3. Lakes, [The identifier P024:003 has been assigned to a set of eight photographs. These photographs include views of Summer Lake and Crater Lake as well as a number of unidentified lakes.]
4. Ocean Scenes, [The identifier P024:004 has been assigned to a set of eleven photographs and seven glass plate negatives. Depicted in this set are ocean, beach and city views of and near Newport, Oregon, unidentified individuals lounging on a beach and other unidentified ocean views.]
5. A pond east of Corvallis, developed for use by waterfowl, February 1958
6. Rivers, [The identifier P024:006 has been assigned to a set of three photographs. Depicted in the set are scenes of a bridge over an unidentified river as well as an image of the Spokane River.]
7. Trees, [The identifier P024:007 has been assigned to a set of three images, two of them negatives. Depicted in this set are scenes of a group of students lounging in a tree-ringed field as well as a log on a river bank with new greenery growing upon it.]
8. Waterfalls, [The identifier P024:008 has been assigned to a set of four photographs, all of which depict unidentified waterfalls.]
9. Bridges, Harbors and Dams, [The identifier P024:009 has been assigned to a set of seven photographs as well as one glass plate negative. The subjects of these photos include views of High Bridge over the Crooked River, 1926; the Hood River Valley; an aqueduct built on the Potomac River; Mary's River Dam, 1903; Possession Point on Whidby Island, Washington; an image annotated "If in doubt Wheelock's Tent City, Drift Creek Falls"; a sign on a wall; and a view of the harbor from the Bekins Building, Vancouver, BC.]
